Nigel wrote and performed in four critically acclaimed mainstage revues at **The Second City**, including **Dreams Really Do Come True (and Other Lies)** and **The Meme'ing of Life**. In 2016, Nigel was assistant director to The Second City's mainstage revue **Come What Mayhem!**. In the 2017 **Toronto Fringe**, Nigel directed the sold-out and award winning show, **Not Oasis Presents: Alone In This Together** while also performing in the same Fringe in **Special Constables**. Nigel can be seen on **Baroness von Sketch Show** (CBC) and **Killjoys** (Syfy); on the web in **The Amazing Gayl Pile** and **My 90-Year-Old Roommate** (CBC Comedy); and in numerous commercials nationally for Canada and the U.S. for brands like Avocados from Mexico and Tim Hortons. Nigel is an improviser, teacher, director, and host, performing in shows and festivals across North America and the UK.

ALLAN TURNER (Writer/Performer)

Allan is an award winning 20+ year veteran of the Toronto comedy scene. He was voted **Toronto's 'Best Male Improviser'** in the 2015 **Now Magazine Reader's Choice Poll**. Allan conceived of and co-wrote the viral and multi award-winning *A Tale of Momentum & Inertia*, an animated short now being developed into a feature film by Fox Animation. For 18 years he has embodied the zombie clown **Jean-Paul Mullet**, now a cult celebrity. Past **Toronto Fringe** shows include **Sour Grapes**, which won Now Magazine's **Best Ensemble** award, **Mullet's Ghost Story**, and **Mullet's Make-a-Play**. Other shows include **Mullet's Night Show**, the hit live variety show that ran for five years, and **Mullet's Dinosaur Adventure**, an all-ages play that sold out its run at the 2013 **Toronto International Circus Festival**. Allan co-hosts **Lunacy Cabaret**, the longest running circus cabaret in Toronto, improvises regularly with his troupe **Assface**, and is a **Theatresports** and **Bad Dog Theatre Company** alumnus. Television credits include **Orphan Black** (BBC America/Space), **Murdoch Mysteries** (CBC), the **Canadian Comedy Award** winning **This Movie Sucks** (CHCH), and **Ed & Red's Night Party** (CityTV/G4), where he was a recurring guest star. Allan is a writer, director, teacher, actor, voice actor, improviser, comedian, and one of the busiest clowns working in Toronto today.
